

Lackawanna College Educational Facility Overview
2016-2017

Lackawanna College's Main Campus in Scranton provides:

- 21 classrooms with seating to accommodate an average of 25 students, although some classrooms are better suited for slightly increased or decreased class sizes. Each classroom is outfitted with technology including a Smart or Team Board and wireless access. Of these, two classrooms function as "Learning Studios" designed with aesthetics specifically chosen to facilitate satisfaction, engagement and learning, as well as mobile furniture and technology to promote constructivist pedagogical strategies. A third Learning Studio is expected to be operational for Spring 2017.
- 4 science labs capable of safely supporting a variety of general and upper level science courses
- 1 sonography lab equipped with various sonography machines to support both instruction and student practice according to accreditation guidelines
- 3 computer labs/classrooms containing between 16 and 18 computers each
- 2 culinary classrooms/kitchen labs outfitted with the equipment and instructional supplies to support our culinary courses
- 1 computer lab dedicated for student use
- 1 suite of classroom and office space dedicated to the paramedic program, outfitted according to accreditation standards
- 1 suite of classroom and office space dedicated to the nurse aide program, outfitted according to accreditation standards
- Student study and collaborative space at various locations

Each satellite location offers classroom, student, administrative, and lab space designed to meet the specific needs of their educational offerings.
